Dear Parents and Guardians of Our Lady's Primary School

I write to extend to you my sincere thanks for the manner in which you and your children have met the challenges presented to education by the Coronavirus and to commend you upon the support you have given to your school's leadership and staff.

This has been a strange time, but one that is also unsettling. The education of our young is a very high priority for us all. They are the future of our nation. They deserve the best we can possibly give them. I am very much aware that Our Lady's Primary School continues to deliver quality learning during this period, even in these difficult circumstances. Your support of the Principal and Staff is crucially important as we move through this period of remote learning.
